The watermain linking Cheney to Limoges is installed

THE NATION – December 17th, 2021 – The new watermain connecting the Cheney water tower to the Limoges distribution system is now installed. Robert Excavation was on schedule by completing the work in three and a half months. The Nation Municipality also wishes to thank the consulting firms CIMA, AECOM and GOLDERS for their hard work in moving this project forward until final completion in March 2022.

Close to 10 km of main pipe was installed underground between the Cheney water tower, along Indian Creek Road, and the Nation's existing water treatment plant in Limoges, along Limoges Road. This project will provide a sustainable water source for Limoges and for all future growth and development. Final testing and commissioning of the watermain will be completed by March 2022.

"I am very impressed with the work done by all parties involved. They worked hard, rain or shine, to meet the deadline. The citizens of Limoges can be proud of the quality of the work accomplished. They will soon have access to a new source of drinking water. ", declared the mayor of La Nation, François St-Amour.
