COVID-19 Pandemic

<u>DECLARATION OF A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY – HEAD OF COUNCIL</u>

Section 4 of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act, R.S.O. 1999, c. E.9

WHEREAS the outbreak of a communicable disease, namely the coronavirus (COVID-19) disease, constitutes a danger of major proportions that could potentially result in serious harm to the residents of The Nation Municipality;

AND WHEREAS on March 17, 2020, the Government of Ontario made an order declaring an emergency under section 7.0.1(1) of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act;

AND WHEREAS the Medical Officer of Health of the Eastern Ontario Health Unit, Dr. Paul Roumeliotis, advised residents to practice social distancing and self-isolation, and ordered the closure of multiple establishments and cessation of many activities across the region, in order to help limit the spread of COVID-19;

AND WHEREAS The Nation Municipality area herein described is encountering an emergency that requires prompt action to prevent harm or damage to the safety, health or welfare of the persons or to prevent damage to property therein;

AND WHEREAS The Nation Municipality wishes to position itself to request financial support from the province when the municipality will be in need in this time of crisis.

Emergency Area: <u>The Nation Municipality</u>

Nature of the Emergency: Propagation of the novel coronavirus COVID-19

AND WHEREAS the undersigned is satisfied that an emergency as defined in the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act exists or may exist in The Nation Municipality as noted above;

AND WHEREAS the undersigned has advised the Emergency Program Management Committee.

THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY DECLARES pursuant to section 4 of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act, a State of Local Emergency in The Nation Municipality, in the United Counties of Prescott and Russell, in the Province of Ontario, as of and from 1:00 p.m. of the 6th day of April, 2020.

THIS DECLARATION OF A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY shall exist until further notice.
