NOTICE of PUBLIC MEETING

DEVELOPMENT CHARGES BY-LAW

TAKE NOTICE that on **Monday October 3rd, 2022 at 6 pm**, Council will hold a public meeting pursuant to the *Development Charges Act, 1997* to receive input on the proposed municipality-wide development charge by-law and background study.

Development charges are fees that are levied on new development in The Nation Municipality to fund new growth-related capital expenditures.

TAKE NOTICE that all interested parties are invited to attend and may provide feedback and/or make representations relating to the proposed study and by-law, either in support or opposition. Those wishing to address Council must advise the Clerk in writing no later than noon on Friday, September 30th, 2022 by e-mail at admin@nationmun.ca. All submissions received in writing and those opinions expressed at the public meeting will be considered prior to the enactment of the new development charges by-law.

TAKE NOTICE that the purpose of the proposed Development Charges By-law is to update the municipality's current Development Charges rates for the next five years, to reflect the growth-related capital expenditures that are identified in the Development Charges background study.

AND TAKE NOTICE that the proposed Development Charges By-law and the Development Charges background study will be available on The Nation Municipality website at www.nationmun.ca by July 26th, 2022.
