Subject: Changes to the hall rental policy

Context

Approval of two changes to the hall rental policy regarding insurance requirements for Nation non-profit organization meetings and partial refund of additional bar service fees for Nation non-profit organizations.

Report

In July 2023, the hall rental policy was revised, and the option was chosen to require all clients who use our community halls to have liability insurance – either their own or to purchase it through a user program offered by the municipality. The program is working well for clients who rent our facilities, but we are seeing issues with our non-profit groups that qualify for free monthly meetings in our halls. They do not pay for the use of our hall but must pay an insurance fee of \$1.16 per hour for a meeting. These meetings are basically less than 10 people, are 1 or 2 hours and are very low risk activities. The paperwork of having to collect such a small sum for each of these meetings is time consuming for staff and our groups are frustrated by the process and having to pay these small amounts.

In August 2023, a change was made to the bar service fees. \$100 + HST is charged for the first 6 hours of bar service. If the client requests any additional time over 6 hours there is an additional charge of \$25/hour + HST. The policy currently allows for approved non-profit groups in the Nation to be refunded their \$113 bar service fee if the bar and restaurant gross profits surpass \$500. Currently the new policy does not allow for non-profit groups to have a refund of any of the additional fees that are charged for additional hours of bar service.

Relevance to priorities

The Parks and Recreation Master Plan encourages support of non-profit groups and major stakeholders of the Municipality.

Financial Consideration

The municipality does not receive any fees from the insurance premiums. Any fees collected are submitted directly to the company. The non-profit organization meetings are low risk and we will continue to charge insurance fees for all other activities – only the meetings will be insurance free.

The additional bar service fee of \$25/hour help offset staffing that is required to be in the building during bar rentals where there are not necessarily a lot of profits during part of the activity ex. afternoon of an activity versus an evening supper & dance.

Refunding only part of the additional fees will continue to generate some additional funds for the

Recommendation

Municipality and encourage our non-profit groups.

That the Municipality makes an exception and waives the obligation to have liability insurance for the approved non-profit organization monthly meetings in community centres.

That Nation non-profit organization qualify for a 50% refund of additional bar services fees charged if gross bar and restaurant profits from the event surpass \$1000.00.
