1.0 INTRODUCTION

Robinson Consultants Inc. was directed by the Municipality of La Nation, in November 2022, to complete work on an Emergency Work basis for the modification and replacement of the low-flow conveyance culvert on the Cross Creek Municipal Drain under the Prescott and Russell Recreational Trail. The culvert under consideration is (1) of (3) culverts at this location and had collapsed. The culvert was also known to cause frequent flooding issues (due to the design of the system) prior to the collapse and was therefore subject to consideration for adequate sizing.

Emergency work was initiated by the Municipality of La Nation and authorized by the Minister of the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture Food and Rural Affairs by letter dated December 21, 2022.

Proposed sizing of the culvert was provided by Robinson Consultants Inc. in support of the Emergency Work and the construction was completed in February 2023.

This report modifies the sizing of the culvert and accommodates the Emergency Work but does not otherwise modify the existing report or By-Law for the Cross Creek Municipal Drain.

2.0 HISTORY

The existing report for the Cross Creek Municipal Drain entitled "Engineer's Report Major Improvements Of The Cross Creek Municipal Drain -- The Township Of Caledonia (Including land in West Hawkesbury and Longueuil Townships)" was completed for the Township of Caledonia by Desjardins/Lascelles Engineering Ltd., dated (Revised) December 8, 1983, (1983 Report).

The associated Township of Caledonia By-Law is By-Law 26-1983.

3.0 PROPERTY AND REQUEST

The official "Notice of Request for Drain Minor Improvement" as required by O.Reg. 381/12 was completed by the operating Authority of the Prescott and Russell Recreational Trail in consultation with the Municipal Drainage Superintendent subsequent to the Emergency work being completed and the bylaw authorizing the work finalized following receipt and finalization of the notice, dated January 15, 2024. A copy of this documentation is provided in **Appendix A**.

The culvert under consideration is located on the Prescott and Russell Recreational Trail, formerly a rail corridor but now owned and operated by a private Prescott and Russell Recreational Trail Authority at approximately Sta. 0+135 on the Cross Creek Municipal Drain, Lot 12, Con 1, geographic Twp. of Caledonia.

4.0 DETERMINATION OF THE ENGINEER

Based on the Drainage Engineer's review of O. Reg. 500/21, the requirements of the regulation allowing for the "Minor Improvement Project" were met, including the following:

7.1(i) 7.2(i/ii)	work completed on an individual property. all costs associated with the work will be paid by either the proponent or the Municipality.
7.3(i) 7.4.	the construction did not require access to neighbouring properties no modification of the assessment schedules was required to complete the work.
7.5.	the activity does not change the existing Drainage Capacity or erosion capacity.
7.6. 7.7.	the activity is not considered an "enclosure" the activity does not take place in a wetland

It was the determination of the Drainage Engineer that all noted requirements were met, and the project could proceed in conformance with O.Reg. 500/21.

5.0 REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS AND DESIGN

Notice of the "On-Site Meeting" as required by O.Reg. 500/21 was sent to the Prescott and Russell Recreational Trail Authority, the Municipality, the County of Prescott and Russell, The South Nation Conservation Authority, and the adjacent landowner. The on-site meeting was completed on November 23, 2022.

Emergency work was initiated by the Municipality of La Nation and authorized by the Minister of the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture Food and Rural Affairs by letter dated December 21, 2022. A copy of the Authorization Letter is provided in **Appendix B**.

Consultation was completed with the Department of Fisheries and Oceans (DFO), the South Nation Conservation Authority (SNCA), the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (MNRF) and the Ontario Ministry of Environment Conservation and Parks (MECP). Where applicable and/or received authorizations/permits are provided in **Appendix C**.

5.1 Design

Primary hydrology and hydraulic calculations utilized in the sizing for this culvert were previously completed by Robinson Consultants Inc. in conjunction with the Mill Creek Municipal Drain, located in close proximity downstream of this location and providing outlet for the Cross Creek Municipal Drain.

Sizing was extrapolated from the calculations completed for the Engineer's Report, entitled "Engineer's Report -- Mill Creek Municipal Drain, Amendment and Emergency Work", by Robinson Consultants Inc., dated January 10, 2022.

Consideration was given for the increase in size of the base flow culvert (as defined in the 1983 Report) to convey the flows up to the 5-year design capacity, while a small check-dam/weir was place between the other (2) culverts at this location, limiting conveyance of the overall system to the original total capacity in conformance with S.7.5 of O.Reg. 500/21.

The original 1200mm dia CSP culvert was replaced with a 3000mm dia CSP, similar in size to culverts located both immediately upstream and downstream of this location and is anticipated to convey flows associated with base flows up to the 5-year design storm event.

A rock check-dam/weir was placed between the existing twin 2950 dia CSP overflow culverts to a height of 1500mm thereby directing flow to only (1) of the overflow culverts first except in exceptional storm events.

Plan and Profile drawings of the work (as completed in February 2023 under the Emergency Work designation) are provided on Plan Dwg. 22073-A1 and Profile Dwg. 22073-P1, dated January 2023 are included in **Appendix D**.

6.0 COSTS

All costs associated with this Engineer's Report and the associated work (as completed in February 2023 under the Emergency Work designation) are to be assessed to the proponent lands.

CORPORATION OF THE NATION MUNICIPALITY BY-LAW NO. 07-2024

A By -Law to appoint an engineer for the replacement of the Prescott-Russell Recreational Trail culvert at Cross Creek Municipal Drain under section 78(5) of the Ontario Drainage Act

Whereas section 78 (1) of the Drainage Act stipulate that if a drainage works has been constructed under a by-law passed under this Act or any predecessor of this Act, and the council of the municipality that is responsible for maintaining and repairing the drainage works considers it appropriate to undertake one or more of the major improvement projects listed in subsection (1.1) for the better use, maintenance or repair of the drainage works or of lands or roads, the municipality may undertake and complete the project in accordance with the report of an engineer appointed by it and without the petition required by section 4. 2010, c. 16, Sched. 1, s. 2 (27); 2020, c. 18, Sched. 4, s. 9 (1).

WHEREAS section 78(5) of the Drainage Act stipulate that despite subsections (2) to (4), the Minister may prescribe the process for approving minor improvements to a drainage works mentioned in paragraph 8 of subsection (1.1). 2020, c. 18, Sched. 4, s. 9 (6).

WHEREAS, The Nation Municipality directed the Drainage Superintendent in November 2022 to complete work on an Emergency Work designation by the Minister of Agriculture, Foods and Rural Affairs, for the modification and replacement of the low-flow conveyance culvert on the Cross Creek Municipal Drain under the Prescott and Russell Recreational Trail due to the collapse of the culvert at this location.

WHEREAS the official "Notice of Request for Drain Minor Improvement" as required by O.Reg. 381/12 was completed by the operating Authority of the Prescott and Russell Recreational Trail in consultation with the Municipal Drainage Superintendent subsequent to the Emergency work being completed and the by-law authorizing the work finalized following receipt and finalization of the notice, dated January 15, 2024.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of The Nation Municipality, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT Council appoint Robinson Consultants Inc. to review the Cross Creek Municipal Drain existing engineer's report to provide a proper design to lower the risks of flooding in this specific area.
- 2. THAT the landowners, of the Prescott & Russell Recreational Trail as deemed proper by the engineer's cost shares, to be responsible for the costs of the revised Engineer's Report as per section 78(5) of the Ontario Drainage Act request.
- 3. THAT by-law shall come into force as of January 15, 2024.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND DULY PASSED UPON THE THIRD READING IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 15th of JANUARY 2024.

Dear Mr. Leroux:

Thank you for your letter dated December 9, 2022, requesting an emergency designation under Section 124 of the <u>Drainage Act</u> to replace a collapsed culvert on the Cross Creek Municipal Drain in The Nation Municipality.

Your letter and the accompanying photographs demonstrate that the culvert is collapsing, reducing the capacity of the drain, and causing water to back up in the drain. You indicate that the culvert is under a recreation trail and close to a residential house which may be affected by the back up of water in the drain.

You indicate that Leroux Consultant has been appointed Drainage Superintendent, but you are unable to use the existing engineers' report to complete the work as maintenance. The municipality is planning to appoint Robinson Consultants Inc. to prepare a report on the Cross Creek Municipal Drain recommending the full replacement of the drainage crossing in accordance with Section 78 of the *Drainage Act*. I would encourage you to take any opportunity to expedite the resolution of this serious issue as quickly as possible.

After considering this information, I hereby designate the replacement of the collapsed culvert (as shown in the pictures in your submission) on the Cross Creek Municipal Drain in The Nation Municipality to be an emergency within the meaning of Section 124 of the *Drainage Act*.

This designation is granted on the condition that the replacement is made under the supervision of Robinson Consultants Inc., appointed by council under Section 78 of the *Drainage Act*. Any additional drain improvements will need to progress through the normal *Drainage Act* process. Since the total project cost is unknown at this time, all involved property owners must be given an opportunity to appeal their share of the project cost to the appeal bodies established under the act.

SCHEDULE A: WORK DESCRIPTION

SNC understands the following work will be completed (the "Work"):

- 1. Emergency Alteration to the Cross-creek Municipal Drain at the Prescott Russell Trial at the above noted location.
- 2. The Main Alignment 1200mm CSP culvert has collapsed and will be replaced by a larger diameter culvert of at least 3000mm dia. of the same length measurement (24m).
- 3. A berm will be built in between the two existing twin culverts of the Bypass Alignment, effectively further dividing flows during storm and flooding events.
- 4. No regrading of the Prescott Russell Trail is expected.

SCHEDULE B: CONDITIONS

SNC requires completion of the following conditions for permit compliance:

- 1. Department of Fisheries & Oceans (DFO) recommendations for environmental protection and mitigation measured should be followed.
- 2. Sediment and Erosion Control
 - a) The Permit Holder is responsible to ensure that no sediment released by the Work enters a watercourse or waterbody.
 - b) The Permit Holder must submit a sediment and erosion control plan for review and approval to SNC prior to work beginning, this plan should be in place prior to, and during, the Work.
 - c) In the event of unexpected rainfall, any fill that is removed from the site and placed on the shore (above the high-water mark) is to be properly stabilized as required through the implementing of appropriate sediment and erosion control measures.
 - d) SNC may visit the Work location anytime from application submittal through to the expiration of the permit to inspect the implementation of sediment and erosion control measures on site. SNC shall give reasonable notice of the entry to the Permit Holder or occupier of the property.
 - e) Disturbed areas must be stabilized and revegetated as required upon completion of work and restored to a pre-disturbed state or better.



SCHEDULE C: ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

SNC makes the following additional comments:

- 1. This permit does not review, certify, or provide permission for any works that may be located outside the above noted property boundary.
- 2. Nothing in this permit relieves the Permit Holder(s) from obtaining, where necessary, regulatory approval from any other agency, government including his Majesty the King in Right of Ontario, municipality, landowner or authority having legal jurisdiction regarding development at the above noted location or any adjacent lands that may be impacted by the Work. SNC makes no representation and has made no representation as to whether the Permit Holder(s) must obtain any other approval(s) regarding the Work. SNC hereby confirms that it is the Permit Holder(s)' sole and complete responsibility to ensure that it applies for and obtains all necessary regulatory approvals prior to undertaking the Work.
- 3. Permit review completed by S. Desouches. Technical review completed by B. Harbers & S. Zand.



SCHEDULE D: GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Term

This permit is valid for 24 months from the date of issuance. No notice will be issued on expiration and it is the responsibility of the Permit Holder to ensure a valid permit is in effect at the time the Work is occurring.

SNC may consider reissuing the permit upon request and payment of an administrative fee. A permit may be reissued where site conditions and plans remain the same as the date of the initial permit.

2. Other Permits and Permissions

This permit does not relieve the Permit Holder of the responsibility to obtain any other documents or permits that the Work may require from the Government of Canada, the Government of Ontario, or the municipality.

It is the responsibility of third-party agents to secure property owner permission to undertake the Work.

3. Transferable

The Permit Holder may transfer the permit to another individual or corporate entity upon payment of an administrative fee to SNC so long as site conditions and plans remain unchanged from the date the permit was issued.

4. Right to Hearing

Every Permit Holder whose permit is refused will be granted the opportunity to present their position in a hearing before the SNC Board of Directors. Please contact our office for further details.

5. Property Entry

SNC may request entry to the worksite at the time of work through to six months past the expiry date of the permit. SNC shall give reasonable notice of the entry to the Permit Holder or occupier of the property.



6. Cancellation of Permit

SNC may cancel a permit or change the permit conditions if:

- a) false information was submitted as part of the permit application; or
- b) the Work deviates from the conditions of the permit without SNC's prior written approval.

7. Liability

The Permit Holder acknowledges that the sole function of this permit is to confirm that the Work is consistent with Ontario Regulation 170/06 and SNC policies. SNC makes no representations or warranties regarding any other aspect of the Work.




